GED Testing

What is the GED?

The General Educational Development (or GED) tests are a group of five tests which (when passed) certifies that the taker has high school level academic skills. The GED tests measure your knowledge and skills in certain academic fields that are generally learned in high school. The GED is for persons 17 years or older who have not completed high school. The GED is equivalent to a high school diploma from the United States and its territories.

How do I sign up to take the GED?

GED test applications can be picked up at any E2CCB Center or at most area high schools. Complete your application and mail it to:

You will receive a confirmation post card in the mail one week prior to the testing date which tells you your test site and date of the test. Please bring two (2) forms of identification (one with a photo).

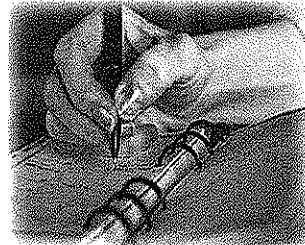

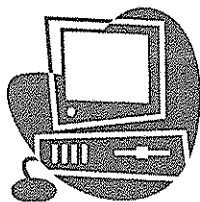
